History

Health Centre was inaugurated on 1st May, 2002 for students and Staff. Initially there were only one Honorary Medical Officer but later on full time post of Medical Officer was sanctioned by State Government. And the regular Health Officer was recruited in the month of March 2017. Now, there is a full time salaried Medical Officer in the University.

Since establishment, University Health Center is providing counseling to out door patients(OPD) and medicines are given free of cost to students and staff.

FACILITIES

University Health Center provides comprehensive Primary and Emergency aid 24x7 to Out Door Patients from 12.00 P.M. to 08.00P.M. on all working days. The working time is extended till 08.00P.M. after the closure of Teaching and Administrative work at 06.10P.M. so that the Hostel students should get benefit of Health Checkup after the closure of their Teaching Departments.

University Health Center has One fully equipped Ambulance working 24x7x365 days. Various types of emergency cases are attended by Medical Officer round the clock or in case of emergency referred to Super Specialty Hospital depending on the extent of emergency under the supervision of Medical Officer with the help of Ambulance.

ACTIVITIES OF UNIVERSITY HEALTH CENTER

During the whole year, University Health Center organizes different Health Check-up Camps, Blood Investigation Camps, Online World Organ Donation Day Programmes, RT-PCR Testing Camps.

University Health Center has provided Medical Assistance to all Cultural and Sports Mega events hosted by University like Inter University Cricket Tournaments and Women's Kabaddi Championship.

During Covid-19 Pandemic, University Health Center has provided Masks, Sanitizers to all Staff working in University. Disinfectant spraying of Sodium Hypochloride is done on priority basis in all the Teaching and Administrative Departments of University and spread awareness regarding Covid -19 health measures.

Fund raised through Corporate Social Responsibility

Recently, Bank of Maharashtra, Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University, Amravati Branch has donated Rs.10,00,000/-only (In Words Rs. Ten Lacks only) from their Corporate Social Responsibility Fund for purchasing Ambulance. Rest of the money is shared by University Fund and a fully equipped Ambulance is there at the disposal of University 24x7x365 days. The Ambulance is inaugurated at the auspicious hands of former Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor Dr. M.G. Chandekar
