

OBJECTIVE OF THE SCHEME

NSS was launched in 1969, the birth centenary year of Mahatma Gandhi. It is one of the centrally sponsored schemes of Govt. of India and a flagship programme of Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Department of Youth Affairs. The thrust of NSS is on character building and personality development of students through community service in a variety of areas of social concern and importance.

SPREAD & REACH OF THE SCHEME

The scheme is in implementation in all the States & UTs. It is operational in 299 Universities, 15666 College and 10,762 Schools and 42 Plus 2 Councils. The NSS has grown from 40,000 volunteers in 1969 to more than 32 lakh volunteers as on date.

COMMUNITY SERVICE & NATION BUILDING ACTIVITIES OF NSS

Every volunteer enrolled under NSS is expected to devote 120 hours annually for at least 2 years towards community service. The Regular Activities include beautification of campuses, awareness campaign, gap filling plantation, education, health, environment, disaster management, rural development, blood donation, awareness about social evils and other socially beneficial issues.

SPECIAL CAMPING PROGRAMMES

Every year 50% of volunteers enrolled in a unit are expected to take part in Special Camps to be organized in adopted villages/slums/areas and undertake community development programme/ creation of durable assets/awareness campaign.
