Resp. Sir,

With reference to above letters, the progress of Broad Band connections in the institutes of higher learning under NMEICT is very low in Maharashtra. Only 712 colleges are covered out of selected 2600 colleges by GoI. You are requested take to immediate necessary action to complete the provision of VPNoBB connections to colleges affiliated to your university at the earliest and submit the progress to the Government every month.

Few major activities of NMEICT are listed below. Details of the scheme are available on MHRD, New Delhi's web site.

- A) Building connectivity & knowledge network among and within institutions of higher learning in country and spreading Digital literacy for teacher empowerment is the main objective in the first phase of the mission. Other objectives of the mission are to develop Efficient Learning Modules, availability of E - Knowledge contents free of cost and providing support for creation of Virtual Technological Universities..
- B) All UGC approved colleges would be provided VPNoBB connections @ 512 Kbps each.

D) Security Deposit, Installation charges and Modem cost are waived off under the scheme. BSNL is giving 10% subsidy over the annual fee of Rs. 5000/- towards broadband uses. Remaining annual fee shall be paid by GoI & institute in the ratio of 75:25. Thus Institution shall be required to pay subsidised fee of Rs. 1125/- per annum for the uses of broad band connection. The billing period shall be from 1<sup>st</sup> December to 30<sup>th</sup> November of every year in advance.

In order to digitally connect India's Educational Institutes and make them e-learning enabled in shortest possible time, all universities are required to issue guidelines and necessary directives to the affiliated institutes to contact BSNL authorities and extend all possible support for the installation of broad band connection. You are also requested to submit the report about number of colleges covered under this scheme to the government every month.

You may also request to MHRD for the inclusion of more institutes than already selected from amongst affiliated institutes to your University.
