Notes : This absorption scheme applies to the students –

1. Who were admitted to LL.M. course existed immediately prior to commencement of new LL.M Course. And -
2. Who are otherwise eligible to get admitted to LL.M 2nd Years as per new course.
3. Who fulfil other norms applicable in this regard
4. The scheme will be applicable to the -
 - a. Students at this University who –
 - i. were unable to promote for the LL.M.2nd year in old course due to non-fulfilment of condition under old syllabus, and
 - ii. now he fulfils the condition to get promoted to 2nd year of LL.M. as prescribed in old syllabus, but since admission to second year under old course has been ceased due to commencement of new LL.M Course.
 - b. Students migrated from other University, who -
 - i. were otherwise eligible to get promoted to LL.M. second year as per their syllabus, and,
 - ii. has got equivalence certificate to get admission in LL.M. second year of this University

Rules regarding Absorption Scheme

1. Student who applies for absorption to the new course of LL.M. Commenced from 2022-23 has to appear for all additional subjects as well as all those new subjects having different nomenclatures as per new syllabus.
2. Student of SGB Amravati University will be eligible to get exemption in the subject as per Annexure – I
3. Student of other University will get exemption for the subject as prescribed by Equivalence Committee.
4. This absorption scheme will be applicable to all students from within or out of SGB Amravati University who are willing to pursue their remaining course of LL.M. from SGB Amravati University.
5. Once absorbed in new scheme, all the rules applicable to new course will be made applicable to the students and his case will be treated as if, he were admitted to the new course.
