# **Report on Resource Person Training Programme for School Connect 2.0**

Detailed discussions on initiatives like Vidyalaxmi Loan and PM-USP, enabling students to access financial support for their educational pursuits.

#### 6. **Digital Education:**

Leveraged platforms such as SWAYAM, Mahaswayam, and SATHEE to enhance digital learning and online resources for students.

7. Career Guidance: Equipped Resource Persons with the tools to guide students in making informed decisions regarding higher education and career opportunities.

## 8. Flexible Curriculum Choices:

Empowered students with the freedom to select courses that align with their interests and career aspirations.

### 9. Inclusive Education:

Highlighted strategies to address the educational needs of marginalized groups, ensuring equitable opportunities for all.

## 10. School-to-University Transition:

Focused on strategies to attract and support school students in transitioning seamlessly to higher education programs.

Dr. Sandeep Waghuley, Director of IQAC, further emphasized the objectives of *School Connect 2.0*, underscoring SGBAU's commitment to NEP 2020. Resource Persons were provided with in-depth training on creating dynamic workshops, using digital tools effectively, and addressing the diverse queries of students.

A total of 139 Resource Persons from affiliated colleges, junior colleges, and university faculties participated, each receiving tailored training to prepare them for the upcoming workshops. Action plans for the workshops, which are set to reach over 15,000 students between January 1–15, 2025, were finalized.
