In fact, the outcomes of the above mentioned three programmes are interrelated each other and may be evaluated by taking into consideration of many aspects concerned with our students'

participation in different curricular, co-curricular, extra-curricular and cultural activities, especially in the context of Arts, Social Sciences and Humanities.

The Programme Outcomes (POs) may be evaluated in terms of 1) rate of enrollment in higher studies i.e Ph.D; 2) rate of employability; and 3) increasing pass out students in competitive examinations like NET/SIRT/ UPSC/MPSC; 4) achievements of students in university examinations, overall pass percentage, placement, and awards / recognitions received by the students.

The Programme Specific Outcomes (PSOs) may be evaluated on the basis of 1) performance of students in the national and international level tests; 2) career options they have adopted and the specialization they have attained; 3) the broader information/knowledge they have accumulated about the interdisciplinary subject; and 4) the participatory learning they experienced in their field visits and field exposure through various extra-curricular, co-curricular and cultural activities.

The Course Outcomes may be evaluated by 1) conducting some module test papers/ Term-End Tests, seminars and assignments test papers, surprise tests, Open Book Examinations, 2) group discussions and Viva-Voice; 3) Field Works, Projects Works; and 4) improvement in soft skills and social skills or communication skills as expressed through students active participation in various extra-curricular, co-curricular and cultural activities.
