The Course outcomes (COs) are evaluated by considering performance of students in internal marks and university examination results. Internal assessment is carried out by considering performance in seminars, assignments and seminar report submission. Results of university examinations have been taken in to account to decide COs.

The Programme Specific Outcomes (PSOs) are estimated by considering standard of dissertation during 4<sup>th</sup> semester. It can also be measured from value education offered by course.

The Programme outcomes (POs) rely on understanding and applying the things in day to day life learned from program. It is measured by the achievement of the students in university examinations and overall pass percentage.

## COs Attainment

CO attainment is defined at three levels. It is based on internal and university examinations assessment, and seminar assignments. CO attainment is defined at three levels in ascending order.

Level-1: 30% students scored more than class average

Level-2: 40% students score more than class average;

Level-3: 50% students score more than class average.

Level-4: 75% students score more than class average.

**The target level is set at Level-3.** It indicates that, the current target is level-3; 50% students score more than class average. The CO attainment is measured and the results are obtained. Based on the results of attainment, the corrective measures/remedial action will be taken.

Course Attainment value has been calculated by using formula as given below-

**Course Attainment value= 80% (University exam) x 20% (Internal marks)**

## PO attainment

PO attainment is defined at five levels in ascending order.

The PO attainment levels are defined as stated below:

1. Level-1: Greater than 0.5 and less than 1.0 - Poor
2. Level-2: >1.5-Average
3. Level-3: >2.0-Good
4. Level-4: >2.5-Very Good
5. Level-5: >3.0 –Excellent

PO attainment is decided by taking in account the *direct method*, which include average of COs and passing percentage, and *indirect method*, that includes POs- Standard dissertation and course content that offering value education.

*The PO attainment target level is set at Level-4*, indicates that, the department is aiming at minimum level-4 (very good) in the performance of abilities of student's. Based upon the results of attainment, the remedial measures are being taken.

PO Attainment value is estimated as below-

**PO Attainment value = 80% (average attainment by direct method) + 20% (Average attainment level by indirect method).**
