Department of Lifelong Learning & Extension ensuring lifelong student centric feedback system. Feedback from students and alumni is sought regularly about teaching, learning resources and about infrastructure for their satisfaction.

Department of Lifelong Learning & Extension develop and apply quality parameters for making it regularly for students learning. We have always engaged in a continuous process of obtaining feedback from students, parents and alumni in a formal, informal way for teaching learning process. Continuous review of learning resources is curried out by respective committees of the department and integrates with annul planning for upgrading academic and other support facilities.

Also, department asses the teachers through their reports. The assessment of the teachers comes through the feedback from filled by the students, which indicates the quality of teaching skills and knowledge of a teacher. Following are be some key outcomes of the feedback.

## Analysis of students feedback

- 87% students are satisfied with the governance including proper assistance / guidance / academic governance provided in the department. 13% students are expecting improvement in handling grievances and resolving it timely.
- 92% students found curriculum to be very effective in enhancing their knowledge and constructive learning.
- 91% students are satisfied with teaching and learning systems of the department and the remaining are of the opinion that more diverse teaching-learning methods should be adopted.
- 89 percent students are satisfied with the assessment system of the university 11% students are still not satisfied.
- 92% students are satisfied with the faculty and the director is being advised to monitor the teaching learning process for further improvement.
- 73% students are satisfied with the physical facilities at the Department.

#### Analysis of teachers feedback

• Majority of the faculty members are satisfied with steps taken by the department towards quality education and development. 86% employers are satisfied with the process of curriculum design and development. 92% employers opine that curriculum is effective in developing and it also reflects the current trends and practises in the disciplines.

### Analyses of Alumni feedback

• 92 percent alumni are satisfied with the process of curriculum design and development. Also alumni opined that the department curriculum is effective for the students development.

## Besides above outcomes there are some suggestions which I have been given after the analysis of the feedbacks.

It has been suggested by many students that the syllabus of M.A. in Lifelong Learning and Extension should consist the study of 10 commandments of Sant Gadge Baba.

Number of alumni suggested that new courses should be started in the department like M.A. Yoga Shastra and P.G. Diploma in Naturopathy and Yogic Science.

It has been appreciated by many feed-backers that Covid positive counselling which was started by the department during pandemic period should be continued.

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
