**Analysis of Feedback on Curriculum**

Feedback is an essential element of the learning process. The Department of Marathi collects the feedback on various curriculum aspects and courses from different stakeholders such as the students, alumni and faculty. The feedback form is in Marathi language as our programme is related with the language Marathi and our medium of instruction is also Marathi. The feedback is collected at the end of academic session and is analyzed by Head of the department. The appropriate steps are taken for curriculum enrichment and the overall improvement of teaching-learning.

**Major suggestions and recommendations:**

Some of the major observations and recommendations from feedback collected in year 2015-2016 and 2016-2017 from students, alumni and faculty are as follows:

- 1) Though the current syllabus of Annual Pattern PG programme is quite satisfactory, structural changes are required as the semester pattern is adopted in education system throughout the country.
- 2) Upayojit Marathi (Applied Marathi) is to be introduced in the M. A. (Marathi) syllabus for enhancing the employability of students.
- 3) MCQ pattern is to be adopted in syllabus to promote the objective knowledge approach.
- 4) The inclusion of topics related to NET/MPSC/UPSC exam should be considered.
- 5) Various literary forms and literary trends should be added in the syllabus.

These major suggestions and recommendations were received mainly from alumni and faculty members and were considered by HOID and those were communicated to members of Board of Studies. Some recommendations were considered for the syllabus restructuring by BOS and the syllabus revision occurred in year 2017-2018.

Major changes in syllabus revision are as follows:

1. Semester system is adopted for MA (Marathi) 1 from year 2017-2018 and for MA (Marathi) 2 from year 2018-2019.
2. Internal Exam is introduced and for that Research Project/Research Work is adopted for 20 marks in each paper and remaining 80 marks are allotted to theory paper. MCQ is also introduced in theory paper for 16 marks.
3. Upayojit Marathi (Applied Marathi) is introduced in the M. A. (Marathi) syllabus for enhancing the employability of students.
4. Various literary forms and literary trends such as Katha, Kavita, Natak, Sant Sahitya, Mahanubhav Sahitya, Loksahitya, Gramin Sahitya, Dalit Sahitya, Striwadi Sahitya, Vidnyan Sahitya, Muslim Sahitya, Balsahitya, Bhashantarit Sahitya are added in the syllabus.
5. Some courses are newly designed to benefit for NET/MPSC/UPSC examination such as Marathi Sahityachi Sanskutik Parshvaboomi. Course on literary trends are also added for the same.

After the syllabus restructuring in 2017-2018 the students are well satisfied with the curriculum.

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
