Amravati University was established on Maharashtra Day, the 1st May 1983 to cater to mostly the educational needs of rural population of western Vidarbha. The university has its jurisdiction within five districts of Vidarbha viz. Amravati, Akola, Yavatmal, Buldhana and Washim. By now, this sapling has grown into a gigantic tree having about 4 lac students. It is noteworthy to state that the University has a lush green campus of 70.63 acres with 22 Teaching Departments, a conducted Model Degree College and nine Faculties satisfying the knowledge appetite of the students. The University pays special attention towards educational upliftment of the backwards and the downtrodden.

Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University has been determined and committed to create a human resource capable of converting challenges into opportunities through imparting training to youth in various aspects of skill development. About the Workshop :

This regional workshop in collaboration with Skill Development & Entrepreneurship Department, Govt. National Skill Development Mission

The National Skill Development Mission was approved by the Union Cabinet on 01.07.2015, and officially launched by the Hon'ble Prime Minister on 15.07.2015 on the occasion of World Youth Skills Day. The Mission has been developed to create convergence across sectors and States in terms of skill training activities. Further, to achieve the vision of 'Skilled India', the National Skill Development Mission would not only consolidate and coordinate skilling efforts, but also expedite decision making across sectors to achieve skilling at scale with speed and standards. It will be implemented through a streamlined institutional mechanism driven by Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE). Key institutional mechanisms for achieving the objectives of the Mission have been divided into three tiers, which will consist of a Governing Council for policy guidance at apex level, a Steering Committee and a Mission Directorate (along with an Executive Committee) as the executive arm of the Mission. Mission Directorate will be supported by three other institutions: National Skill Development Agency (NSDA), National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC), and Directorate General of Training (DGT) – all of which will have horizontal linkages with Mission Directorate to facilitate smooth functioning of the national institutional mechanism. Seven

sub-missions have been proposed initially to act as building blocks for achieving overall objectives of the Mission. They are:

- Institutional Training, (ii) Infrastructure, (iii) Convergence, (iv) Trainers, (v) Overseas Employment, (vi) Sustainable Livelihoods, (vii) Leveraging Public Infrastructure.

Maharashtra Skill Development Mission

Vision:

To create and provide the skilled youth for Entrepreneurship Development the Govt. Of Maharashtra has established Maharashtra State skill development society (MSSDS). The Hon'ble Chief Minister has been shouldering the responsibility of Chairman of State Apex Committee.

With its contribution 13% to the Gross National Domestic Product and with a share of 9.28% in the national population, Govt. Of Maharashtra has set a vision of equipping 45 million persons with employable scheme by the year 2022.

Aims and Objectives :

It aims at developing action plans for the various groups in the state viz.: SC, ST, VJNT, Minorities, Below poverty line, Females, Rural, Urban, Tribal's, etc. The main objectives of this mission is strategizing the effective utilization of the existing training infrastructure and eradicating the training based deficiency within the state and imparting based training also to identify the skilled development deficiencies decisive steps to eradicate the same and progressive increase of the skilled development initiative within the state.
