

## **Foreword**

Any institution does have its journey, and some people become a part of it, contribute and help the journey to the new progressive height. Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University is also not an exception to this notion. The journey of the university started way back in 1983 and I, being the seventh Vice-Chancellor of this university, joined the process in 2016. Higher Education in India has started accepting new changes and becoming more vibrant, innovative and student- oriented. There is a welldefined and well-crafted process of regular assessment and accreditation of Higher Education institutes by NAAC, Bengaluru. As Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University is ready to go for its 4 th cycle assessment, it is a time of selfevaluation and look for the progressive ventures undertaken by my team in the last five years. This is really a moment of accomplished feelings to know that in the last five years, my team has dedicatedly strived to achieve excellence in almost all sectors of this enormous process which is carried out through 29 PG departments on the campus, 394 affiliated colleges in the five-district jurisdiction of the university and one constituent college.

The significant achievements that became the

distinctive features of our progressive journey can be summarized based on six important parameters. The First and

foremost is the stupendous increase in the Physical and IT infrastructure on the campus. Almost all the departments are provided with sufficient infrastructure to carry out the effective and technology-based academic process.

The second aspect is the digitization of almost all functions related to general administration, examination, and teaching-learning. It feels proud to tell that during this pandemic period, almost the whole of the teaching-learning sessions was digitally accomplished with the incredible response of the students due to the availability of computing facilities, internet facilities, virtual classrooms, recording studios where teachers have exerted themselves in developing e-content for the students.

The third target was to open new avenues for the students in the form of new departments. We have started 9 new departments on the campus, and 5 more are proposed from the next session, expanding our choices in all faculties of studies. We have also started more than

100 new short-term courses through our lifelong department, offering education to all at any time.

The fourth important aspect was to adopt a national-level standardization policy in academics. We have dedicated worked for it and now all set to introduce Choice Based Credit System for UG and PG programmes to offer many multidisciplinary, open skill, and research-oriented choices to our students. One of the important features is the inclusion of skill-based modules in the regular curriculum, assuring competence to our students to face the competitive challenges of the world.

The fifth aspect is the socially oriented approach based on Sant Gadge Baba's saying, by whose name our university is known. In the last five years, many activities were organized to reach out to the common people in the society, and training beyond the campus is offered to the students. The establishment of the COVID-19 testing lab on the University campus, where our dedicated teachers and students are working strenuously to serve the people, became an embodiment of our social commitment. In the projects like Snehanubandh and Runanubandh, we have initiated counselling for the senior citizens suffering from depression in this pandemic period. This counselling was done by the trained teacher counsellors of our university. The establishment of the regional centre of Unnat Bharat

Abhiyan is also an embodiment of our social approach through which we have started reaching out to the rural people and formulating their progressive development with various activities and programmes.

The final aspect for which the university is known is the Research. We feel proud to count more than 900 research papers of the teachers in reputed systems like SCOPUS and Web of Science. A total of 26 patents are published by the teachers in the university till date. Some of them are considered very useful, and the process of technology transfer was also executed accordingly. The research-oriented approach is propagated to the students who excel with their innovative research ideas in prestigious competitions like Aawishkar.

Thus, looking back for the last five years, the dedication of my team will undoubtedly prove as a significant step in the overall development of the university. I feel proud to lead this great Public University and find myself fortunate to have colleagues who strive hard to accomplish my vision about this university that I had seen five years before. 




