### **BIRTH OF GAUTAM BUDDHA**

At that time the King of Kosala had seen sixteen terrifying or the second or the se

Seated under the Bodhi-tree at Buddhagaya he attains Samma Smabodhi and becomes the Supreme Buddha.





So he decided to kill the Buddha One evening, while the Buddha One evening, while the Buddha was walking past a nearby tocky hill, Devadatta pushed a huge stone down the hillside, intending to kill the Buddha. But the rock suddenly broke into many pieces and only one sharp piece hit the Buddha's foot. The Buddha returned to the monastery and was treated by the famous physician Jivaka.

Unable to accomplish the Master's request, she comes to the conclusion that death is inevitable and that her only son too had succumbed to it.
