iii) Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) Course: Elective courses offered under the main discipline / subject of study is referred to as Discipline Specific Elective. i) Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC):- The Ability Enhancement Courses may be of two kinds: Ability enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC) and Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC).
