- Internship Apprenticeship / Field Work / Work Experience is Mandatory. - OEC (Optional) can be studied during semester I to VI, its credits and grades will be reflected in final semester VI credit grade report. OEC may be opted from Sem I to Sem V. It is comprised of GIU, Skill Course and MOOC (through SWAYAM).
- Minimum 10% of the total credits of the UG (Bachelor's Degree) programme, that is, at least 12 credits are mandatory to be earned by all the students from Ancillary Credit Courses as
