Appendix – A2.

1) Examination and question pattern of M.A. (Gender & Women's Studies). Degree Programme:-

1) Examinations shall be conducted in Offline mode in accordance with Ordinance No. 9. However, under special circumstances and in specific cases, those can be conducted in Online mode on the recommendations of Board of Examination & Evaluation and approval by the Academic Council.

- 2) An examinations shall be held at the end of each semester.
- 3) Question paper of examination shall be in English, Marathi and Hindi as applicable.
- 4) The question bank for theory/subject/paper (MCQ, Long answer should be prepared along with memorandum of answers..
- 5) Syllabi of respective papers have been divided in to five units for each paper/subject.
- 6) Weightage shall be equal for each unit of the respective paper/subject.
- 7) All questions in the question paper shall be compulsory.
 - The distribution for examinations shall be :-

i)**Theory** : The Theory Paper for 60 Marks shall be set with only one question on each unit with internal choice & MCQs based on all the units.

ii) **MCQ**: There shall be 20 MCQs for each subject. MCQ will have 1 Mark each. There shall be a question bank consists of at least 1000 questions to be prepared by BOS from all units. The 20 questions in multiple sets shall be automatically and randomly chosen by the software selecting questions from each unit. The students will be provided with OMR sheets along with regular answer books and they will solve MCQ by using these OMR sheets.

- 8) **Internal Assessment** : There shall be 20 Marks for internal assessment in each theory paper. It shall comprise of Class Test / Assignment / Seminar / Group Discussion etc ..
- 9) **Practical** : Practical shall be as prescribed in the syllabus..
- 10) The course teacher / faculty member shall design Rubrics for each Internal Evaluation. Rubrics are scoring tools that define performance expectations for learners. The course teacher shall seek approval for the Rubrics from the Principal/ Director/ Head of the Department/ other designated academic authority of the College/Institute/University Department. The course teacher / faculty member shall share the approved Rubrics with the students at the start of the course. The Rubrics shall have the following details.
 - a) Linkages of the Internal Evaluation to COs (Course Outcomes).
 - b) A description of the assignment brief concepts note.
 - c) Criteria that will be assessed the expected learning outcomes.
 - d) Descriptions of what is expected for each assessment component the expectation from student.
 - e) Substantive description of the expected performance level indicating mastering of various component the assessment criteria.
 - f) The team composition, if applicable.
 - g) The format and mode of submission, submission timelines
 - h) Any other relevant details.
