**Age as on 09.09.2015:** The upper age limit is relaxable by 5 years for SC/ST and 3 years for OBC candidates with respect to posts reserved for them. Upper age is relaxable by 10 years for PwD (Persons with Disabilities) candidates, cumulative age relaxation is available for those PwD candidates who belong to SC/ST/OBC category. Ex-servicemen candidates will be granted age relaxation as per Govt. directives. Those domicile in the state of Jammu & Kashmir from 01.01.1980 to 31.12.1989 will be allowed 5 years relaxation in upper age limit. For departmental candidates the upper age limit shall be 45 years for the post of Operator cum Technician (Trainee/ Boiler Operation).

### Qualification

**For Operator cum Technician (Trainee/ Boiler Operation):** The SC/ST/PwD and Departmental Candidates having Diploma in Engineering in the required discipline with minimum 40% marks shall be eligible to apply.

The submission of online application/ registration process involves following three steps:-

- Go to the nearest branch of State bank of India bank with Pay-in-Slip and deposit the required amount in Bank. State Bank of India has been authorized to collect the application and processing fee, in a specially opened account No. 32549519300 at Sector -1 Branch, Bhilai, on behalf of BSP, SAIL.
- Candidate will have to bear the bank charges in addition to the applicable application fee.

**Step 3: Final Registration and Printing of Provisional registration Slip**

- On receipt of the money, the concerned branch of SBI will issue a unique Journal Number and a Branch Code of the branch collecting the money. It will be written in the Pay-in-Slip by collecting branch of SBI. SBI will retain one copy of Pay-in-Slip (Banks copy) and return two copies (BSP's copy and candidate's copy) of the same to the candidate.
- Feed this unique journal number and date of payment written on the Pay-in-Slip in SAIL's website before closing date of website after logging in to generate provisional Registration Slip.
- In case a candidate deposits the fee in a wrong account, or doesn't finally submits application form with payment details, application will be rejected as incomplete and SAIL, BSP will not be responsible.
- No request for editing payment details and issue of Admit card will be entertained in wrong submission cases and candidature will stand rejected.

### **Important News in Brief**

#### **National Investment and Infrastructure Fund**

The creation of National Investment and Infrastructure Fund (NIIF) was announced in the Union Budget 2015-16.

Union Cabinet has recently approved the setting up of National Investment and Infrastructure Fund (NIIF).

The fund will make equity investments of Rs. 20,000 crore every year in commercially viable long gestation projects which will help to kick-start the economy.

The Centre will own 49 per cent of this new Mumbai-based fund, which won't be answerable to Parliament nor audited by the CAG.

It will be run on a commercial basis by managers, who will be paid globally competitive salaries.

The NIIF is modelled on Singapore's investment vehicle Temasek.

#### **World Population Prospects: The 2015 Revision by UN DESA**

1. The current world population of 7.3 billion is expected to reach 8.5 billion by 2030, 9.7 billion in 2050 and 11.2 billion in 2100.
2. By 2022, the population of India is expected to surpass that of China.
3. Nigeria will be the third most populous country in the world surpassing the United States in 2050.
4. Globally the number of persons aged 60 or above is expected to more than double by 2050 and more than triple by 2100.
5. China's population will start declining by the 2030s, while India's is projected to decline only after 2069 when its population is around 1.75 billion.

#### **Zero Hunger Challenge**

The Zero Hunger Challenge launched by the United Nations Secretary-General Ban Ki-moon at the Rio+20 Conference on Sustainable Development in June 2012, encapsulates his vision for the future – a world free from hunger and malnutrition - where all people enjoy their fundamental Right to Food; and people's livelihoods and food systems are resilient and able to withstand a changing climate. This vision is articulated in the five pillars of the Zero Hunger Challenge, namely:

- 100% access to adequate food all year round;
- zero stunted children less than 2 years of age;
- all food systems are sustainable;
- 100% increase in smallholder productivity and income;
- and zero loss or waste of food

#### **Exercise Indradhanush -IV**

India U.K. Joint Air Exercise conducted from Jul 21 to 30 in U.K.

Four Sukhoi Su-30 MKI along with IL-78 Air-to-air refueled, C-17 strategic and C-130J tactical airlift aircraft of the Indian Air Force participated in the exercise.

Euro fighter Typhoon from the Royal Air Force along with Boeing E-3D Sentry and A330 Voyager tanker were pitted against the Indian aircraft.
