7. Leave your troubles at home, attend the interview with an open and with full determination to succeed.
8. Be very clear and precise in your answer, do not try to bluff but speak with confidence.
9. Look into the eyes of the person interviewing you, be courteous, courageous and have no fear.
10. You should have a clear idea as far as possible regarding the nature of the job for which you are a candidate.
11. Never give anybody's reference that so and so has sent you or knows you.
12. Before leaving the room thank the employer, close the door behind gently.

CONSTITUTION OF 21ST LAW COMMISSION OF INDIA

The Union Cabinet approved the Constitution of the 21st Law Commission of India, for a period of three years w.e.f. 1st September, 2015 to 31st August, 2018.

The 21st Law Commission will consist of :

1. Fulltime Chairperson;
2. Four fulltime Members (including a Member Secretary);
3. Secretary, Department of Legal Affairs as ex off do Member;
4. Secretary, Legislative Department as ex office Member; and
5. Not more than five part-time Members.

The Law Commission shall, on a reference made to it by the Central Government or suomotu, undertake research in law and review of existing laws in India for making reforms therein and enacting new legislations. It shall also undertake studies and research for bringing reforms in the justice delivery systems for elimination of delay in procedures, speedy disposal of cases, reduction in cost of litigation etc.

IMPORTANT NEWS IN BRIEF

Launch of W-20

1. What is it?: An engagement grouping of women leaders from G20 countries, to push for gender inclusive global economic growth.
2. The beginning: The W20 was launched at the G20 meeting of Finance Ministers and central bank governors in Turkish capital Ankara.
3. The President of W20: Ms. Gulden Turktan has been appointed the first President of the group.
4. The first summit : 0708 Oct 2015
5. Venue of first summit: Istanbul, Turkey.

SOVEREIGN GOLD BONDS SCHEME - SALIENT FEATURES

1. The scheme will help in reducing the demand for physical gold by shifting a part of the estimated 300 tons of physical bars and coins purchased every year for Investment into gold bonds. Since most of the demand for gold in India is met through imports, this scheme will, ultimately help in maintaining the country's Current Account Deficit within sustainable limits.
2. Sovereign Gold Bonds will be issued on behalf of the Govt of India by the RBI, on payment of rupees and denominated in grams of gold.
3. The bond would be restricted for sale to resident Indian entities. The cap on bonds that may be bought by an entity would be at a suitable level, not more than 500 grams per person per year.
4. The Government will issue bonds with a rate of interest, either floating or fixed, to be decided by the Government.
5. The bonds will be available both in demat and paper form and in denominations of 5,10,50,100 grams of gold or other denominations.
6. Banks/NBFCs/Post Offices/ National Saving Certificate (NSC) agents and others, as specified, may collect money / redeem bonds on behalf of the government (for a fee, the amount would be as decided).
7. The tenure of the bond could be for a minimum of 5 to 7 years, so that it would protect investors from medium term volatility in gold prices. Since the bond, will be a part of the sovereign borrowing, these would need to be within the fiscal deficit target for 201516 and onwards.
8. Bonds can be used as collateral for loans. Bonds to be easily sold and traded on exchanges to allow early exits for investors who may so desire.
9. The amount received from the bonds will be used by Gol in lieu of government borrowing and the notional interest saved on this amount would be credited in an account "Gold Reserve Fund" which will be created.

10. On maturity, the redemption will be in rupee amount only. The rate of interest on the bonds will be calculated on the value of the gold at the time of investment. The principal amount of investment, which is denominated in grams of gold, will be redeemed at the price of gold at that time. If the price of gold has fallen from the time that the investment was made, or for any other reason, the depositor will be given an option to roll over the bond for three or more years.

IMPORTANT NEWS IN BRIEF - OCTOBER

INDIA'S INTENDED NATIONALLY DETERMINED CONTRIBUTION (INDC)

India has submitted its action plan to the UN climate body, UNFCCC. Every country is submitting these action plans, called Intended Nationally Determined Contributions, or INDCs, ahead of an annual climate change conference in December to be held in Paris. India has submitted its Intended Nationally Determined Contribution (INDC) to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change. Some of the salient points of the INDC are:

- To put forward and further propagate a healthy and sustainable way of living based on traditions and values of conservation and moderation.
- To adopt a climatefriendly and a cleaner path than the one followed hitherto by others at corresponding level of economic development.
- To reduce the emissions intensity of its GDP by 33 to 35 per cent by 2030 from 2005 level.
- To achieve about 40 per cent cumulative electric power installed capacity from nonfossil fuel based energy resources by 2030, with the help of transfer of technology and low cost international finance, including from Green Climate Fund.
- To create an additional carbon sink of 2.5 to 3 billion tonnes of CO2 equivalent through additional forest and tree cover by 2030.
- To better adapt to climate change by enhancing investments in development programmes in sectors vulnerable to climate change, particularly agriculture, water resources, Himalayan region, coastal regions, health and disaster management.
- To mobilize domestic and new and additional funds from developed countries to implement the above mitigation and adaptation actions in view of the resource required and the resource gap.
- To build capacities, create domestic framework and international architecture for quick diffusion of cutting edge climate technology in India and for joint collaborative R&D for such future technologies.
